THE INTERNATIONAL ARENA AQUAMASTERS SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS

GUIDELINE

Due to COVID-19 outbreak, which was announced by The World Health Organization as a pandemic, we will organize the **International Arena Aquamasters Swimming Championships with all the measures of the controlled social life.**

The championship will take place with special measures and regulations, and with limited participation.

This guideline includes new regulations and measures, and the detailed program will be announced before the event on our website www.aquamasters.org and on our social media accounts.

APPLICATION AND REGISTRATION

Registration will be online on our website www.aquamasters.org

On the **IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS** on our website www.aquamasters.org, you will find the COVID-19 Commitment Statement.

> **All swimmers are required to read the COVID-19 Commitment Statement, to fill in the information at the bottom of the document completely (Name, Surname, Passport Number, Mobile Phone Number), and to sign it. The original signed document should be submitted to the crew at the accreditation desk.**

All the participants have the responsibility to go over all rules and commitments presented in championship reglements. They are required to declare their intent with the statement **“I hereby read and agreed all rules and regulations”** on the application form.

All swimmers are required to submit their official licenses for swimming, water polo, triathlon or modern pentathlon with a valid 2020/2021 visa, or a health certificate received in the last six months. **One of these documents should be submitted to the jury before the event.**

ACCREDITATION AND KIT DELIVERY

- A limited quota is reserved for foreign swimmers, who will be accredited with their passports and commitment letters. Foreign swimmers are also required to fill in and submit the COVID-19 Commitment Statement.
- The accreditation and kit delivery dates and locations will be announced on the program, which will be online before the event.
- The swimmers are required to have their original signed copies of COVID-19 Commitment Statements ready, and submit them during the accreditation and kit delivery process.
- **Due to COVID-19 measures, no audience will be allowed.**



- Swimmers have to wear their masks at all times except the competition. All swimmers are required to bring sufficient number of masks with them.
- All referees, organizational crew members and media members have to wear masks at all times during the event.
- All swimmers, referees, organizational crew members and media members have to pass through the temperature point. Their fever will be checked.
- Any swimmer with a temperature of 38 degrees and over will be checked again in 5-10 minutes, and in the case that the result is similar, the swimmer will be dismissed.
- Due to COVID-19 measures, food courts are not allowed in the event area.



BEFORE THE COMPETITION

Due to COVID-19 measures, Technical Meetings will not take place, and instructions will be announced online on our website www.aquamasters.org and on our social media accounts. A basic technical brief will take place just before the start.

The swimmers are required to have worn their swimsuits before they enter the competition area.

The swimmers are required to wear their masks and follow the physical distance rules until the start.

Accredited swimmers will pass through the Temperature Point and enter the competition area in groups of 10.

START

The swimmers will be grouped according to their ages.

They will take off their masks just before the start, and the masks will be disposed in covered bins.

Groups of 5 swimmers will start in each 15 seconds – 20 swimmers per minute

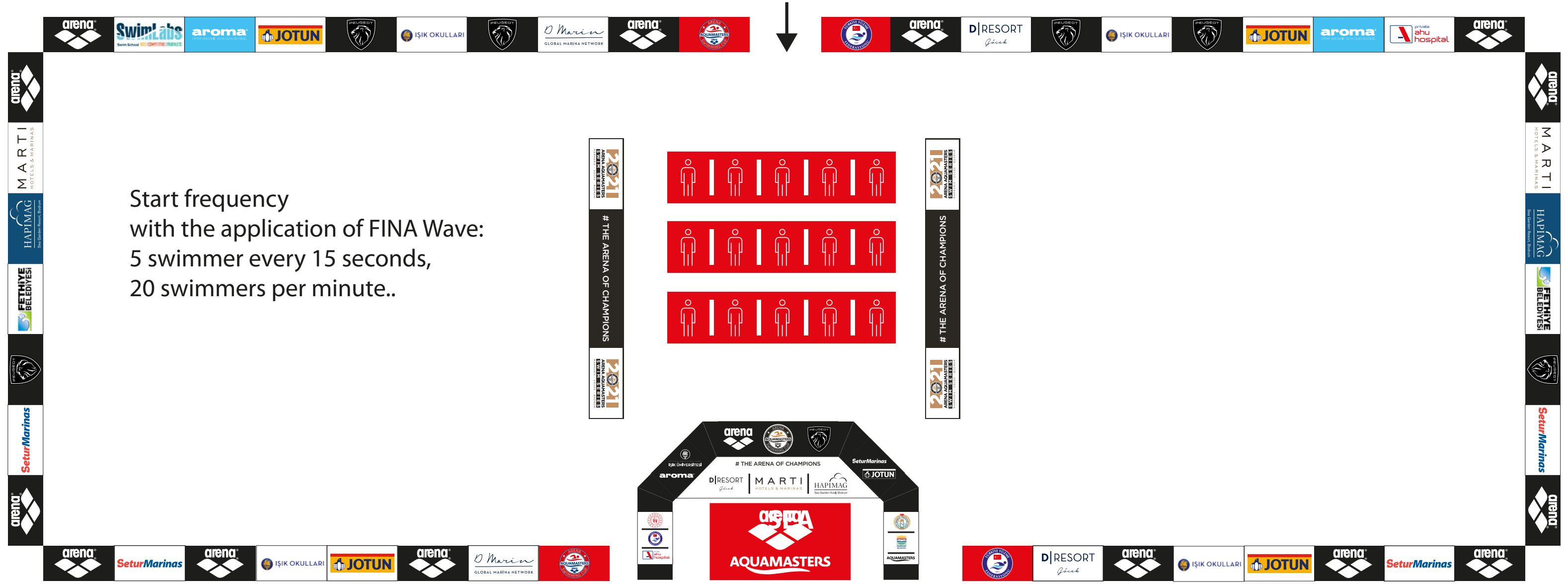
AFTER THE COMPETITION / AWARD CEREMONY
